**NOTICE OF TELEPHONIC PENALTY ASSESSMENT PRE-CONFERENCE
AND
PENALTY ASSESSMENT CONFERENCE**

The parties shall take notice that a telephonic Penalty Assessment Pre-Conference (“Pre-Conference”) will be held in regard to the above styled and numbered matter on July 1, 2026 at 2:30PM, prevailing Eastern Time. The purpose of the Pre-Conference is to discuss the timeliness of the Request for a Penalty Assessment Conference (“Conference or “PAC”), to simplify and clarify issues, to explore the possibility of settlement, and for any other purpose as may be appropriate. The parties should call the Office of Administrative Hearings’ (“Office”) on the conference line at 1-**866-889-3903** on the date and at the time set for the Pre-Conference. After the prompt for the conference code, enter **47911231#**. If a party has problems connecting to the conference line at the scheduled Pre-Conference time, please contact the Office directly at 1-**502-564-7312** and report the problem immediately.


The parties shall further take notice that, pursuant to 400 KAR 1:110 Section 4, a Penalty Assessment Conference (“Conference”) will be held on July 8, 2026 at 10:00AM prevailing Eastern Time, or at such other time as agreed to by the parties during the Pre-Conference, this Conference will be held telephonically instead of at the Pikeville Regional Office, Department for Natural Resources, 121 Mays Branch Road, Pikeville, KY 41501. The purpose of the Conference

is to provide an opportunity to contest the amount of the Proposed Penalty Assessment. No information pertaining to the fact of any violation can be considered by the Conference Officer during the Conference.

Upon conclusion of the Conference, the Conference Officer will consider all relevant information pertaining to the Proposed Penalty Assessment. Within thirty (30) days after the Conference, the Conference Officer will issue a Report recommending that the Secretary affirm, raise, lower, or dismiss the Proposed Penalty Assessment. If a person or entity fails to attend the Conference, the Conference Officer will issue a report to the Secretary recommending that the Proposed Penalty Assessment be affirmed.

All parties should note that the Kentucky Bar Association has determined that the appearance by an individual who is not a Kentucky licensed attorney on the behalf of a third person, corporation, or another entity at a Conference constitutes the unauthorized practice of law. Corporations or other entities must be represented by counsel at the Conference. Individuals may represent themselves.
