Subject: TENORM in Estill County

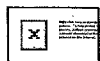

I am emailing you to tell you what I would like to see done about the TENORM situation here in Estill County. Based on "the way crow flies" I live about ONE air mile from the Estill County landfill site. First of all, the TENORM should NOT have ever been allowed to be dumped off here in the first place. Based on that, my first "gut" reaction is that I would like for the material to be moved somewhere else. BUT if one thinks about this and uses a little "common" sense, it will cause more harm to disturb it and to try to move it elsewhere. The EXACT location of the TENORM in the landfill is not ACCURATELY known. Only an approximate location and depth. By digging and moving dirt and garbage, the dust from this will become air-born and go to who knows where and settle. The dist will be breathed by all the workers, neighbor to the landfill and the school children right across the road. The mess will even be blown to my house and I do NOT want that. So, based on what I have said here, I feel leaving the TENORM where it is now and to NOT disturb it is the best choice of the two options available to us. So:
